

Princelet Street

Located on one of the finest Georgian streets in London, within easy reach of the Square Mile, this magnificent threebedroom loft apartment occupies the entire first floor of a converted textile factory. With approximately 2,411 sq ft of accommodation on one floor, it is one of the very few genuine lateral living spaces in the Spitalfields Conservation Area.

The property is presented to the market in immaculate condition, having been refurbished by the current owner. Materials of the very highest quality have been used throughout, including extra-wide solid timber floorboards by Dinesen.

There is private lift access directly into the flat, as well as a staircase from ground level. An entrance hall leads into the vast reception room and dining area, which in turn leads to an open-plan kitchen. The property has three double bedrooms, two with en-suite bathrooms, as well as a guest cloakroom. It is equipped with generous amounts of built-in storage.
